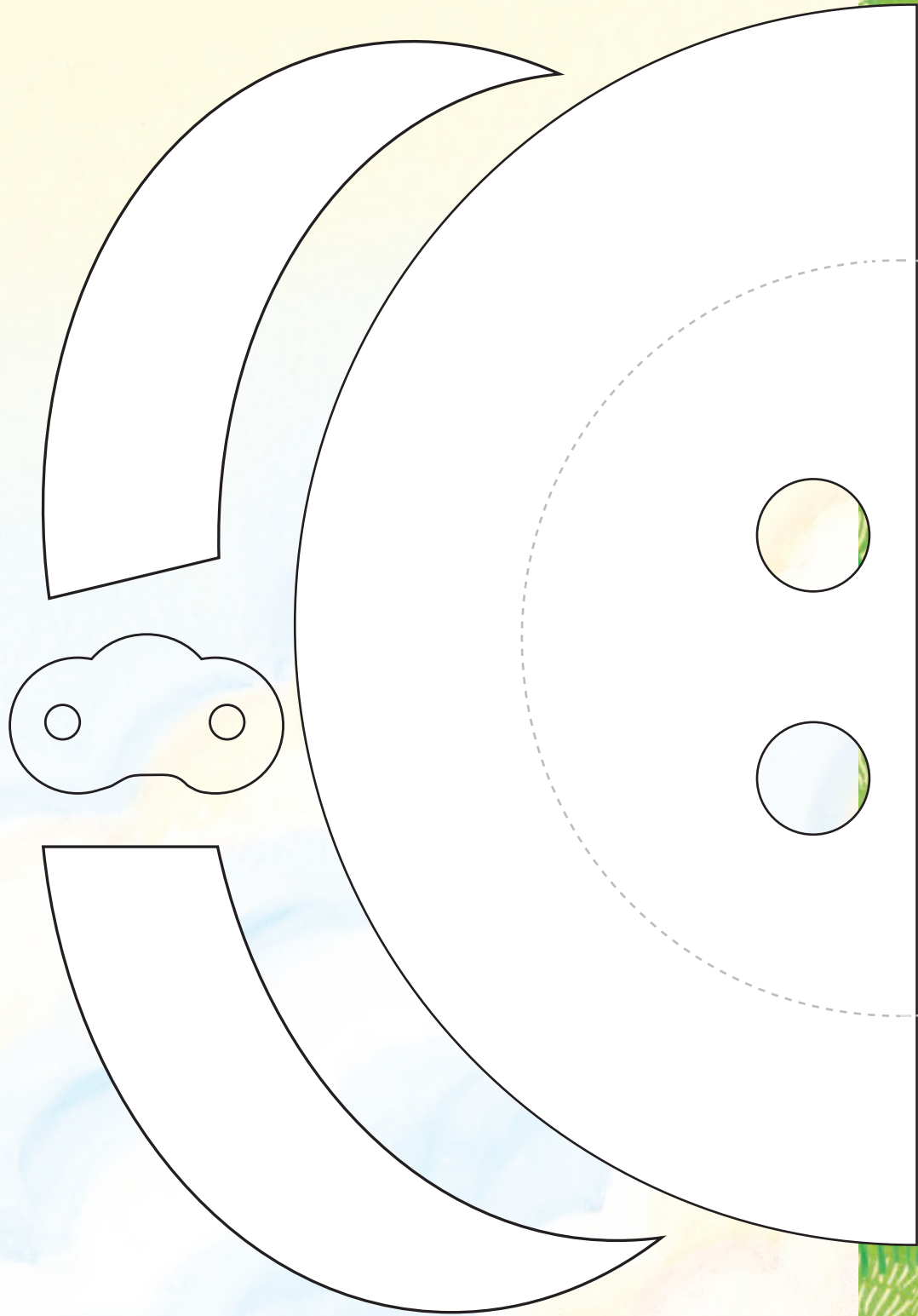


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MAKE YOUR OWN BUFFALO FACE

INSTRUCTIONS:

- To create your own buffalo, color the pieces on this page. Use whatever color you want for the face, eyes, nose, and horns.
- Ask an adult to help you cut out the pieces.
- Glue the horns to the rounded part of the semicircle.
- Glue the snout to the space in between the two little circles which will be the eyes.
- **Optional:** You can even add yarn, glitter, or whatever else you want to add to your buffalo.



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
