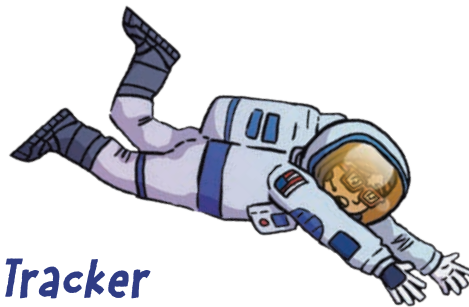

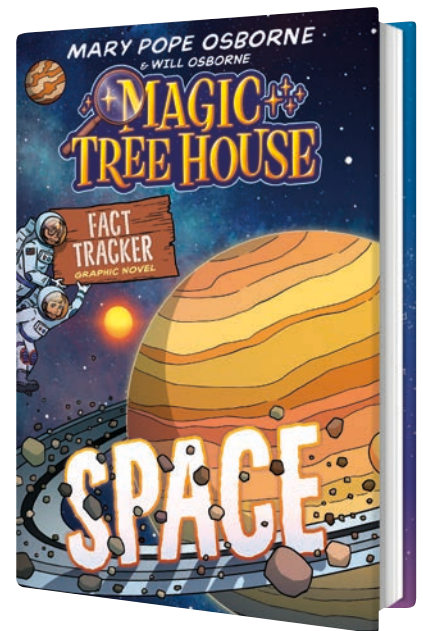
Midnight on the Moon Graphic Novel

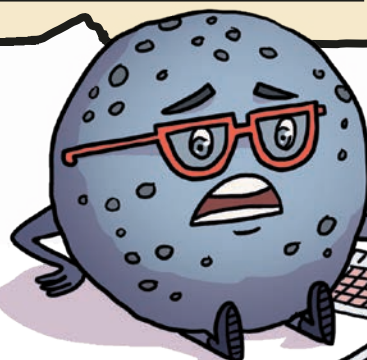
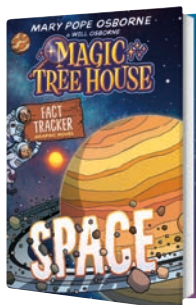

Example

SOL

In Latin, *sol* means *sun*

What are other words and related phrases in this word family?

solar—relating to the sun

solstice—the longest or shortest day of the year, when the sun reaches its highest or lowest point

parasol—an umbrella that protects you from the sun

ASTER/ASTRO

In Greek, *aster/astro* means *star*

What are other words and related phrases in this word family?

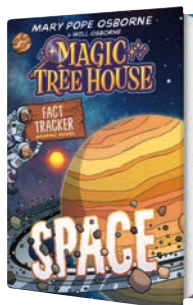
TELE

What are other words and related phrases in this word family?

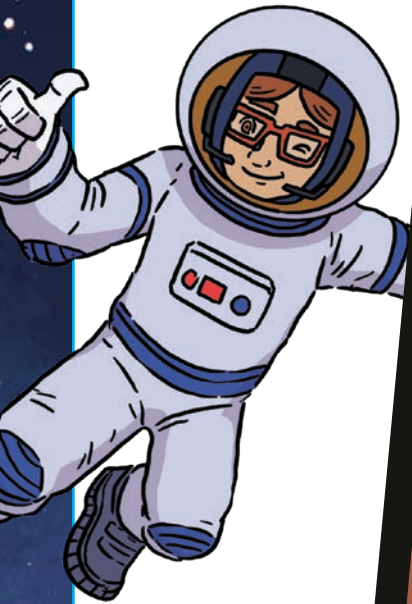
